When wildfire smoke exposure occurs together with other harmful exposures, such as emissions from factories, highways, toxic chemical waste, and extreme heat, the compounding effect is particularly harmful to children's development. These compounded exposures are more likely to occur in neighborhoods that have experienced longstanding discrimination and disinvestment.
