

VIRTUAL SAFE BABIES TRAINING

The Safe Babies Foster Parent training is an educational program for those interested in becoming caregivers of children under the age of 3 who have been exposed prenatally to drugs and/or alcohol. This training will occur on Mondays and Wednesdays over the course of 5 weeks starting Monday, March 29, 2021 for 2 hours a day. Foster Parents, Caregivers, MCFD/Delegated Aboriginal Agency staff and community partners who work with Safe Babies homes are welcome. This training will be presented by the Support To Family Care Network Team and guest presenters for each module.
